NEVADA EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Enacted 2015 • Launched 2015 • Tax-Credit Scholarship

Corporations can claim a 100 percent tax credit for contributions to approved Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGOs), nonprofits that provide private school scholarships, counted against the Modified Business Tax. Taxpayers may carry forward a tax credit under this program for five years. The total amount of tax credits awarded statewide is limited to \$5 million in 2015-16, a limit that increases 110 percent each year. Beginning in the 2015-16 school year, scholarship-granting organizations (SGOs) in Nevada will provide scholarships to students to attend private school.

Latest Stats (2015)

•50 percent of families income-eligible statewide

• Maximum scholarship value: \$7,775

• Maximum value as a percentage of public school per-student spending: 95 percent

Program Details

Scholarship amounts are determined by SGOs. The maximum scholarship is \$7,775 in 2015-16, a limit that increases by the CPI increase each year.

Student Eligibility

All students receiving scholarships under this program must come from families whose household incomes are at or below 300 percent of the federal poverty line (\$72,750 for a family of four in 2015-16).

No legal challenges have been filed against the program.
